WALKING THE BEATITUDES

I have been very much aware that the beatitudes Jesus spoke in Matthew, Chapter Five have not been emphasized in church teaching because there was no spiritual will to keep them. But, today is a new Day and the Spirit is teaching us a new way.

I want to share an experience from one of our spiritual daughters. (How we thank the Lord for each one of you, and also our sons. You are greatly beloved). This daughter, Janice, is a steadfast believer and a conscientious worker. On a new job, her two supervisors treated her in a cold manner. One, who was in a position to evaluate her performance, kept deducting marks for grammatical “errors” that were *not* errors! When Janice pointed this out, instead of receiving another 40% mark, she got 18% on her next evaluation!

That is enough to anger anyone, I'd say! “But,” she told me, “I realized that complaining was not the answer, so I felt I should pray blessing upon both supervisors. I didn't feel to pray just a general blessing, so I prayed specifically: ‘**Lord, bless them with truth, peace, and justice.**’

“I prayed this for over a week and could hardly believe the difference it made in those two ladies. My direct supervisor gave me a 94% evaluation twice and both of them began speaking to me as if I were now an acceptable member of the human race. What a marvelous lesson to learn: to return blessing for cursing; good for evil. Of this I am

now sure—this is a kingdom principle and I shall learn to use it always.”

As a further development to this story, I have to tell you that Janice received 100% in six evaluations in one week. She was given a certificate of merit for good work. The other employees knew she had been blessing the supervisors, so their reaction was, “Blessing works better than ‘appealing’ which is the only recourse we have. We think we should change our tactics and start blessing our supervisors too.”

At lunch break, for half an hour they peppered Janice with questions about her faith. Later, they asked her if she would go dancing with them that night. One of them had a birthday, and they were going out to celebrate it with her. Janice felt free in the Lord to say “Yes” to their invitation.

The girls looked surprised. “But, you’re a Christian. We want you to come but we didn’t think you would.”

“Yes, I am a Christian, and Jesus will be going with me.”

“But I thought Christians weren’t supposed to go to places like that. The dance is being held in a bar, you know.”

“That won’t bother me. Jesus met men wherever they were. And as for drinking, I don’t *need* any of that!” (And, having observed her joy in the midst of trials, they knew she had drink that they knew not of!)

When they arrived at the bar, Janice’s older daughter was there. She turned her back to her mother and did not speak as she had been doing for some time on many occasions. Janice’s friends were upset with her and wanted to go and harass her and give her a hard time for treating her mother like that. Janice said, “No, don’t do that. She is walking in a place now where she has to learn some things and I don’t want to hinder that.”

At the bar, there was little dancing, for the questions continued, unabated, for three hours. For example, different ones said: “I’ve gone to church but I’ve never heard anything like what you are telling us.”

Janice answered, “It is not about church, or a building, or an organization. It’s about a **relationship!** That’s why Jesus died—to reconcile us to our Father so that we could have a relationship with Him!”

One commented, “So *that* is why you’re always happy and are not stressed like we are about losing our jobs. You say the Lord is in charge of

your life and you do your work as unto Him and you will be here as long as He wants you to be. Wow! No wonder you can be happy!”

The time came for a Happy Birthday song for the birthday girl. They asked Janice to sing, so she sang our version:

**A happy birthday to you,
A happy birthday to you
May you find Jesus near
Every day of the year.
A happy birthday to you,
A happy birthday to you,
And the best year you’ve ever had!**

The birthday girl’s eyes were wet when she said, “You have made my day!”

At the end of the evening some of the girls said, “Your own daughters are crazy to have rejected you as their Mom. Could you be a Mother to *us?*”

I don’t know how our readers will “see” this, but I am seeing the kingdom of God in action here. When the sons are revealed to the world shall it not be in the nature of Jesus, and shall not the people seek them out to know His ways?

SONG OF THE BRIDE

Song of Solomon 5:15 “....his belly is as bright ivory overlaid with sapphires.”

The word “belly” is understood to be the seat of the emotions, being identical with the word for deep feeling where the bride says, “My bowels were moved for Him.” The verse implies that the Lord Jesus was a person who was moved with great feelings of love for His people.

Ivory is obtained at some pain, from the elephant’s tusk. In similar fashion, the Lord’s love was born out of His sufferings unto death as a Sinner-bearer. His deep feelings were a result of the greatness of His suffering and death which He underwent for His people. This bright ivory is another precious symbol of Christ’s human body. His body appeared to the Jews as a poor, weak tent in which dwelt an unknown, despised and rejected man. But to the Father and His bride, it was bright ivory overlaid with sapphires, for in Him dwelt all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.

The 45th Psalm describes the pure human body given up to God, as an ivory palace. It is *wrought* ivory, which shows the working of the Holy Spirit as our Lord learned obedience through the things that He suffered. In like fashion, His members upon earth are “ivory palaces”, bright and shining, being wrought upon and perfected, made fit to be manifested with their glorious Head.

The ivory, smooth and shining, encrusted with blue sapphires, show forth our Lord, wrought upon by the Holy Spirit until every lesson of obedience was learned through suffering. The heavenly blue of the sapphires covered Him so that all who beheld Him marveled.

The ivory that was “overlaid with sapphires” indicates heavenly clearness, as in Ex. 24:10 “And they saw the God of Israel: and there under his feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in his clearness.” These sapphires were overlaid upon His deepest feelings, so that when those feelings of love move out to His loved ones, how heavenly and transcendent they appear!

5:15 “His legs are as pillars of marble, set upon sockets of fine gold.” Legs signify the power to *stand*. The word for “marble” is from the same root word as “fine linen,” or “white, whiten, to bleach.” Marble is capable of taking a high polish. “Pillars” speak of stability, so the bride was speaking of her Beloved—of all that He was in Himself, and all that He had established in the strength of His righteousness, as having immovable stability. There was nothing in Him that could

be shaken. There was no shadow of turning in Him!

In the stability of His purpose, God's plan was much higher than simply restoring man back to the Garden of Eden. God's plan is to bring him up to the heavenly Garden of God. He lifted man from sin and degradation and made him a new creature in Christ Jesus. Instead of the place of being set over the beasts and all the earth, He has raised him above all principalities and powers and made him sit in heavenly places with Christ Jesus. God's own right arm brought His salvation. With legs that were "pillars of marble" (righteousness), set upon sockets of fine gold (divine nature), He went forth in unflinching strength. There was no lameness or failure in Him. His legs were not unequal. They were pillars of marble, well able to carry every last soul back to God, for He stands in our behalf at the right hand of God, a priest forever after the order of Melchisedec.

The sockets of fine gold are the golden sandals He wore, symbolizing the divine. As a pillar is set in a socket to make it steadfast, His legs are represented as being made steadfast in the power of God. His feet were clothed with the preparation of the gospel of peace and were upheld by the power of God so that they could not slip.

The bride's description of Her Beloved shows His human body as pure ivory, His Head as pure gold, with gold sandals upon His feet. In all, showing that He is clothed with the power of the Godhead and the authority of the deity. From the ivory of His pure manhood, to the gold of His divinity, no spot or impurity is found anywhere.

5:15b "...his countenance (appearance) is as Lebanon, excellent as the cedars." The bride of the Lamb has described her Beloved, beginning with the white and the red which set Him apart from all others. Then, she speaks of the many banners that float above His head because of His victory at the cross. Then, in detail, she sets forth His head of most fine gold and describes Him from head to foot. Now she exclaims that His appearance is like Lebanon, excellent as the cedars.

Lebanon (whiteness) was named because of the snow that crowned its head and of the white limestone found there in abundance. This lofty, snow-crowned mountain sets forth the majesty of Christ, both as Son of Man and Son of God. As the snow water from Lebanon flows down to water the valley below, so does the pure water of life flow from Christ to water fallen humanity.

The cedar tree is an emblem of His pure humanity. It is durable and neither rot nor worm can work upon it, thus it depicts Christ's pure manhood. Oh, what a Saviour we have!

EXAMINED BY SCOURGING

What would you say to a deeply committed young Christian who has been mocked in her place of work and presently is unable to find a job? She is an American of Nigerian extraction and has a good education. We are proud to claim her as one of our spiritual daughters.

The latest indignity she has suffered is having to take a drug test in applying for a certain job. The test results were indefinite because her urine sample was so clear that she was under suspicion of drinking a lot of water to obscure the results. She drinks plenty of water daily for her health and this has made her "suspect" for trying to hide an intake of drugs! For someone who has kept herself pure and has never touched drugs, this was quite humiliating.

I really didn't know what to say except to pray that the Lord would intervene, for she needs to work to support herself in college. We both rejoiced when she shared what the Lord had spoken to her about the situation.

"The Lord has told me that He is **examining me.**" I sought His word for me today and He answered through two different scriptures:

Colossians 1:22-23: "...yet now has he brought you back as His friends. He has done this through His death on the cross in His own human body. As a result, he has brought you into the very presence of God, and you are holy and blameless as you stand before Him without a single fault. But you must continue to believe this truth and stand in it firmly. Don't drift away from the assurance you received when you heard the news. The good news has been preached all over the world and I, Paul, have been appointed by God to proclaim it." (New Living Translation)

Psalms 26:2: "Put me on trial, Lord, cross-examine me. Test my motives and affections."

"At this time I don't know why the Lord is cross-examining me. I can only think of Jesus when He was being examined before Pilate and how Joseph was faced with temptation through and through. One thing I know is that they were both exalted to higher ground for God's purposes.

I only have the prayer of Habakkuk in my heart right now.” (Unquote from Grace).

“The Lord God is my strength; and He will make my feet like hind’s feet, and He will make me to walk upon my high places. To the chief singer on my stringed instruments” Hab. 3:19.

Before His crucifixion, the Lord was **examined** by Pilate, who said:”...**Ye have brought this man unto me, as one that perverteth the people: and behold, I, having examined him before you, have found no fault in this man touching those things whereof ye accuse him:.....I will therefore chastise him, and release him” Luke 23:14,16.**

In Acts 22:24, Paul was treated in the same manner. **“The chief captain.....bade that he should be examined by scourging; that he might know wherefore they cried so against him.”**

Acts 28:18 sums up the matter: **“Who, when they had examined me, would have let me go because there was no cause of death in me.”**

We ask, “Is the disciple above his Lord?” If it happened to Jesus, shall it not also happen to His Body on earth? David, under the anointing, confirms the matter: **“Examine me, O Lord, and prove me; try my reins (will) and my heart.”**

Saint, if you find yourself in a difficult place, ask the Lord if He is ‘examining you.’ Instead of feeling rejection from man, know that your Father is allowing this “scourging” for His own good purposes in your life. Thank Him for what He is bringing forth in your life through it!

THE WHITE CALVARY

God’s Divine Intervention: In 1918, near the end of World War I, hundreds of German soldiers witnessed the “White Battalion.” It happened near the little French town called Bethune. A German officer later told the British that his troops were in fine spirits, believing the British were now defeated and all that was left was to capture Paris where they would drink and carouse to their heart’s content.

“That same day, my lieutenant suddenly became alarmed as he sighted a large body of mounted men approaching the town from the other side. They were all dressed in white and were mounted on white horses—a most unusual sight. We wondered who they could be. Whoever they were, we would blow them to pieces with our heavy artillery.

“We began to feel terror when we saw them advancing like the tide, with not a man or a horse falling to the ground! Our eyes were wild when we saw the leader wearing at his side a great sword like one used by the Crusaders. Suddenly, we knew that we were defeated. My men fled, terrified and afraid. We had lost the war because of the White Cavalry. Hundreds of Germans saw them, but the English say they didn’t see them at all.” Obviously, they were an answer to prayer!

SURRENDER VERSUS SUBMISSION

I have been using the word “**surrender**” for at least four years. Last night, while writing in my journal, I realized that in my conversation with the Father that I said I would “**submit**” unto Him. It caught my eye immediately, for it is not a word I use. I knew spiritually that I had arrived at a new destination in the heavenlies. Whenever I sing songs like “I Surrender All”, I am always transported into rapturous worship, with lots of tears. “Surrender,” to me, has always been a place of “giving-up”. For the past four years, I have been surrendering to the cross and to Christ, all of me, my hopes and desires, my natural strength, my very self. This has not always been an act of the **will**. I have ultimately been brought to a place where, to quote a recent prophecy over me, **“You are now in a place in Me that you are unable to bring forth in the smallest degree anything from your own power.”**

Oh, how I have fought this process of death in me; how I’ve even yearned for life to get back to normal (Egypt). I’ve desired the familiar, and was willing to sacrifice the life Christ promised, for it seemed unfamiliar and unattainable. This promised land was beyond *my* control and grasp, so Jesus had to take my control away!

The concept of “**submit**” holds a whole new place in Christ for me. It means my will has now become His will. I am not giving-in, I am **abiding and agreeing** with His loving authority. I know now that His promise to me five years ago, **“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you; plans to give you hope and a future” (Jer. 29:11)**, has finally come to pass. It’s been a tremendously hard and arduous journey, but I have learned to trust and submit, for I have lost confidence in my flesh.

I am unsure of where this will take me. I do not even desire to soulishly imagine. My hope is assuredly in Him, and to Jesus be all the glory. He has proven Himself faithful and true. And even now, when all circumstances would have me filled with fear and worry, I am confident in my High Tower and Refuge. How could I not submit and abandon myself **willfully** to His authority! (“Will-fully” here meaning “by choice, voluntarily.”) The prophecy given to me also stated, “Therefore, beloved, do not grieve in your soul that you lack power, but confess as David, that you will bless the Lord at all times, His praise being continually in your mouth.”

I felt to compare the two words: “surrender and submit” to shed some light on their differences.

Surrender: “giving up.” **Synonyms:** abandonment, abdication, acquiescence.

Antonyms: fight, victory, win

To give up in favor of another.

To give up or give back (something that has been granted; as surrendering a contractual right).

To give up or abandon: surrender all hope.

Submit: “comply.” **Synonyms:** abide, accede, acknowledge, acquiesce, agree.

Antonyms: defy.

To yield (oneself) to the will or authority of another.

To subject to a condition or process.

To commit (something) to the consideration or judgment of another.

It was during this dealing that Elaine felt of the Lord to send me this prophecy given to **Norma Theriault**. It spoke directly to where I was walking. Perhaps it will help someone else today.

“You are now in a place in Me that you are unable to bring forth in the smallest degree, anything from your own power. I have weakened you in order **that you may possess Me fully** and (so) that whatever comes forth from your hands will only be of My making. Therefore, beloved, do not grieve in your soul that you lack power, but confess as David did, that you will bless the Lord at all times, His praise being continually in your mouth.
