THE INWARD JOURNEY

On May 11th I saw turbulence coming, and I experienced the sense that it was time to shift gears and move into new understanding. I also sense that there is a new crop of brethren on their way to meet with us and that is God is preparing the way for them. We may be surprised at how far along they are spiritually!

The truth is that God has placed within each of us a desire to serve Him, **but this must be tempered with our need to know Him!** It is out of knowing Him that we are able to minister His life. Any other ministry is nothing more than a form of godliness. Our desire to serve Him often leads us to attempt to do things in our own ability. Buried deep in the heart of man is the desire for self-preservation. This desire is so strong and intuitive that “self” finds a multitude of ways to reinvent itself so it can survive. Understanding this truth is crucial to our growing up in Him.

How often we fail to see that the calling of God to come out of the religious systems of man is only the beginning of our journey! It is a much longer process removing the spirit of Babylon from us! In our journey to know Him He often strips us of ministry and gifts for service. His gift and anointing often become diffused with our carnal reasoning and self-efforts. This confusion is called Babylon. In this place we encounter the spirit of anti-Christ, that part of our Adamic nature that seeks “self” rule!

Every time we receive a revelation or new understanding from God it is but a part of the process of knowing Him. He gives us a foretaste of new truth and then He has us walk it out so it can become part of us. In this process His word in us begins to discern our thoughts and intentions, and the Holy Spirit exposes the hidden “self” that opposes all that is of God!

When Jesus walked the earth and preached about the coming kingdom, the people who surrounded Him did not understand the truth He shared. They knew the scripture foretold of a coming Messiah, but they were looking for a Savior

from the tyranny of Rome and not the tyranny of “self” rule. Jesus said His kingdom was not of this world, but that it was within us. The enemy was not Rome, or even the devil; it was “self” rule that opposed Him. I do not deny that there is a devil but more often the root of the problem is “self”.The idea that God wants to **change the heart of man rather than his environment** is too much for the carnal mind to accept. In order to be changed from within, something must die to make room for His life. How many times have we prayed, asking God to change things **without** when He wants to change what is **within**? It is because of the self-preservation in each of us that we cannot see the truth of the Kingdom! That is why Jesus said, “To him who **overcomes** I will give the **hidden** manna.” Manna was food from heaven and all believers can partake of God’s spiritual provision. But here Jesus is saying that there is a hidden manna that He has reserved for those who overcome. There are many things He wants to show us but we must be willing to lay down our human reasoning. Deep within, our human reasoning “self” is there, waiting to reinvent “self” as it seeks a way to survive.

....Believers who continue in their journey to know God, see one consistent theme from Genesis to Revelation: Christ in you, the hope of glory! The Kingdom of God is within us. Starting with the tree of the knowledge of good and evil and the tree of life, we see a picture of the internal dilemma each of us faces as he decides which tree to eat from. Our natural instincts are no different from Adam’s, so by nature we will choose to partake of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. When God calls us to feed from the tree of Life, we must first walk through the flaming sword, for no flesh (self) can partake of the Divine nature. All that is of “self” must be severed from us and consumed in God’s refining fire!

God’s dealings with Abraham have great significance to our inheritance that we receive by faith. Continuing on our journey, we see all of God’s dealings with Israel speak to us about our journey to know Him. We begin in the land of

Egypt (the flesh) and are led by the spirit into the wilderness. Because of our unbelief and carnality, we are unable to immediately enter the Promised Land so we circle the mountain until we learn to cease from our own “self” efforts and enter His rest. Each of the feasts of Israel speaks of our spiritual development and His kingdom within us. Great spiritual realities are hidden in the symbolism of these literal events.

First, we come upon the Passover Lamb without blemish that takes away our sins. Next, we partake of the first fruits of the Spirit at Pentecost. Here we experience His power to be a witness to the world. Then, as God calls us to experience the Feast of Tabernacles, we learn to be still before Him in the confines of the limited space He has given us in our individual booths, usually in the wilderness. We begin to see how God instructed the Tabernacle to be made to the exact pattern, and then we find that pattern is a shadow of the reality found in Christ. At His crucifixion He cried out, “It is finished,” just as the veil in the temple was torn. What Divine synchronization took place that day as *reality overtook the shadow displayed through natural Israel and the first covenant that was written on tables of stone.*

Can we not see that the truth of God is spiritually discerned? How often in the ministry of Jesus was He speaking a spiritual truth while the natural man stood by interpreting with the human reasoning rather than the understanding that comes from eating from the tree of life. When He spoke to Nicodemus and told him he must be born again, poor Nick was trying to comprehend how a man could possibly reenter his mother’s womb. When He spoke of the temple being destroyed and raised again on the third day, He was speaking of His body, but those who heard His words could only see an earthly temple.

If we are truly called out unto God we no longer look *outward*, but we see the reality of God’s kingdom within us. Do not be deceived by carnal understandings that would direct our attention outward, away from the dealings of God. Unless we learn to rule and reign over our individual earth (us) we will not be partakers in the Divine nature that will set creation free.

For those who are seeking the Kingdom of God, everything in the Bible points to the inward journey to know Him and to overcome all that is not of Him! Do not be deceived by the spirit of anti-Christ that is constantly seeking a way to di-

rect our attention outward so that “self” can go undetected, all the while reinventing “self” so it can fit the latest religious trend as it continues to look for ways to rule in the temple of God.

When the Holy Spirit speaks to us, let us not be like those who could only see the natural and therefore miss what God is doing.

Your recent word about Our Present Testing in the May/June issue of Gospel of the Kingdom has inspired me to share what has been happening to me. Not long ago I was in a religious social setting. I asked the Father all evening, “Why do you have me here?” During the closing prayer I had a visitation from Jesus. He said to me, “I love these people too. Will you allow me to love them through you?” In an instant, He allowed me to feel His love, humility and compassion. I tell you that my life immediately changed. I was taken out of the church world over 30 years ago. My Father has dealt with me and taken tons of the Babylonish church system out of me. The testings were severe and thorough. The Spirit said loudly in my ears, “Do not judge these people. You have no idea how I am dealing with them.”

1--The Speaking Word: “Did you not know that when My children’s wills would be aligned with Mine; when their desires would be no longer to please self, but to please Me only, that I would grant them the power to speak for Me? I felt a question in my spirit and upon looking to the Lord, I heard Him say: “Man hath sought out many inventions” (Eccl.7:29) I have natural remedies for the natural man, and spiritual remedies for the spiritual man. Observe how many who are promoting natural remedies know not Me, but are encouraging their hearers to preserve their lives by self-effort. He had been there longer than anyone but Love had brought to him the mystery of the incarnation—of His indwelling life that quickens our mortal body.)

VISION OF THE TWIN THEATERS

When this vision began, I found myself as though I were an usher in a theater. All my focus was on the huge backstage area that was packed with people. I was told that they were anxiously preparing to go on stage to act out everything that they believed to be right.

Suddenly someone called out, ”The Lord is coming!” From the people’s reactions I could tell that they had not been expecting Him to come, nor did they desire Him to be there. I heard them saying, “I have got my rights! I got my rights!” I realized that this stage was just a platform for each one to act out his own beliefs as well as his judgments of others, and his own opinions of how others should live their lives as Christians. I wondered why the stage was covered with beach sand.

For the opening act, all of the thousands of people came on stage carrying a banner that said, “Christian.” They greeted each other with a hug and told each other that they loved them;.

I saw a wolf walk up on stage, greeting each one in the same way. Then he began to preach, declaring how he thought God ought to be worshipped. Some turned away from him and some agreed with him and they followed him. The wolf drew a line in the sand that completely compassed their little group. Other wolves came on stage until the people were all divided into groups and changed their banners to the name of a denomination. They

seemed friendly to each other until one crossed the line of what they believed to be right and then they spoke evil of them. They agreed, “At least we serve the same God; and we agree to disagree; and we believe that it is our “right” for us to do so.”

As the curtain fell on this act, I heard the Lord say, I Cor. 1:10, “Brethren, **I beseech you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (Christian), that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.**” He added, “**This is what is right in the sight of the Lord.**”

For the second act, the stage looked like a carnival with many side-show booths. The first hawker was trying to entice people into playing a game entitled “Three steps to a better marriage.” promising immediate results. The next booth promoted “Five easy ways to financial success.” The next booth had a game, “Prosper and gain favor and grace with God through the Ten Commandments.”

Next came “the blame game.” A person told the barker, “I did not seek the Lord because I just did not have any time to seek Him.” The barker stamped his hand with a stamp that read, “APPROVED: Self-justified.” Another said, “I did not cast any of my cares upon the Lord because I did not have any belief that the Lord really loved me enough to take care of me; bam, “APPROVED: Self-justified”. The next guy said, “I know that I should have forgiven this man, and not have slandered him, but he really offended me and hurt my feelings, and I feel that I am just in hurting him also”. Again the barker stamped him Approved. Another said, “I know that I have followed after false doctrines and religious traditions, but I only did so because everyone in my family also did the same”. The line of people was very long and everyone left smiling as though their own self-justifications had freed them from guilt. Then the Spirit spoke: “**But to him who works not, but believes on him that justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted for ‘righteousness’**”.

The next booth was similar to a game I had played when a child. Stacks of balls were placed on a counter at the front of the booth. A man came out and stood in the back of the booth. The hawker yelled, “This man has been accused and judged to be a child molester” and everyone stepped forward and began throwing the balls as hard as they could at him. I could hear that they were stones, and not balls. The man was dragged out and another

brought in and accused of some crime such as drinking beer or smoking cigarettes, or eating fried foods, or for wearing fashionable clothes, or of being in the wrong political party, or for his race, or his nationality, or for committing adultery. Each time the stonings took place I realized that the ones who were throwing stones had bruises on them so that they also had been stoned.

Yet, the barker was able to get everyone to participate in a game in which they had also been hurt many times over. When their stone hit the person, they were given an "Official Certificate" that says, "This certificate is your official certification that gives you righteous justification and excuse to judge, or to accuse, or to speak evil, or to condemn, or to find fault with, or to murder, or to slander, or throw stones at all those who have hurt you in any manner.". This game seemed to be the one that people most enjoyed playing. It is the favorite sport of the self-righteous.

As the curtain fell on this act, I wondered who this barker was that could deceive the people of God into being so eager to inflict such pain upon those whom Jesus Christ came into this world to save. The Spirit spoke, **"It is just a sport for Satan to kill, to steal, and to destroy the lives of all the saints. It is also a sport for those who have been deceived by him to inflict the same pain on others. Truly, everyone who has judged without mercy is also going to be judged without mercy; seeing that God is going to judge them with the same judgment by which they have measured and judged others.."** As the curtain fell, I heard neither cheering nor booing; just an eery silence that seemed to swallow up the entire theater.

The next act showed different groups of people sitting at tables with an open Bible in front of them. They were discussing different doctrines. Each person would use the scriptures to back up what he believed to be the "right" interpretation. If someone disagreed with him, he would interrupt them. It was not long before much strife and arguing broke out as each one seemed willing to defend to the death that which he believed to be right. No one desired to learn the truth of the matter, but wanted only to defend that which they believed to be right.

I heard other groups discussing the rapture, tithing, and speaking in tongues. Just like the first group, each one used the scriptures to back up his interpretation. The curtain went down leaving eve-

ryone on stage still arguing and defending their own opinions. Still, not one peep of noise could be heard from the audience. Only silence.

When the curtain arose for the next act, I saw what looked like a podium in the middle of the stage. It stood about eight feet off the floor and you had to climb a set of stairs to stand at it. I saw a man step up to the podium and proceed to declare all of the righteous works that he had done. Next, another came who boasted about how often he prayed and fasted, as well as how much money he gave to his church. A woman spoke of her work in a soup kitchen. A man spoke in detail about the importance that tradition had in his church. All declared what they believed was the right way for a Christian to live. Not one person seemed to be listening as each one boasted of their own goodness, and righteous works, will-power, determination, intelligence,. Everyone was so enamored with self that they could not hear anything that did not seem to be beneficial to self. It was as if the person who came to the podium did not even exist in the eyes of the others who were on stage.

As the curtain went down, I heard these words: **Psalm 39:5, "Truly, every man at his best state is altogether vanity (worthless, vain). I Peter 1:24, "All flesh is as grass, and 'all of the glory of man' is as the flower of grass. The grass withers, and its flower falls way. But the word of the Lord endures forever."** What does a man glory in except those things which he believes and does for himself? And what man believes or does anything; that he does not believe is right?

Suddenly, the lights came on and I was shocked to see that this theater was more like a football stadium in size.. But I was more shocked to see that there was only one person sitting there. It was Jesus and he had watched everyone play out those things which they believed to be right. He stood up and said, **"I have seen all the works done here, and I have heard all of the words that have been spoken; and all that I have seen is vanity, and all that I have heard is vanity; vanity of vanities. This is the act that is, but is not; and that was, and was not, and neither shall it ever be."**

Then Jesus walked to an exit which was an entrance into another theater and said, **"Come out of there and follow me."** It was all lit up and I saw a person sitting in about every fifth seat and many greeted me and told me that they had witnessed the same show and were told by Jesus to follow

Him into this theater. I sat down about five seats from the nearest person.

In the middle of the stage was a large beautiful chair. Beside it was a bag like the bags that postmen used to carry. When Jesus walked on stage, the theater erupted with great rejoicing and praise, quite a contrast to how He was received in the other theater. With smiles of great joy, He sat down and greeted everyone of us saying, **“Thank you for believing on Me and on My words. Thank you for waiting for Me to come to finish the works that I have started. I want to thank you also for enduring My correction, and not loving the corruption of “self.” I want to thank you for believing My word by taking up your crosses and dying to your own desires to be god over your own lives; dying to the lies that have enticed you to believe you can do good of your own self, as well as the lies that have sought to deceive you into believing that you can make your own opinions to be the truth** I remembered what Jesus said in John 15:5, **“Without Me, you can do nothing.”** Then Jesus said, **“Thank you for your patience and your faith.”**

Jesus reached down into the bag which contained the prayers of these saints and read aloud the prayer on a card. “Lord, we have been as scattered sheep for so long; for there has been division and strife among us, and we know that the members of your church should be like-minded, as well as esteeming the lives of our brethren to be greater than our own. Lord, you have asked us to do what we have no wisdom of ourselves to do; thus it is impossible for us to be that body which you desire to have. If You are willing at this time, would You bring your flock together?” This seemed to be the prayer of each of us there. Jesus simply said, **“Unity, Be”** and suddenly we all found ourselves sitting right next to each other and we felt that we had known each other all of our lives and had all been best friends.

We had bodies of a 20-year-old and faces of a 6-year-old. Jesus, smiling, again said, “Abra Cadabra”, and we found ourselves standing on top of the water of a beautiful mountain lake. We were amazed at the feeling of walking on water when Jesus said again, “Abra Cadabra” and animals and birds came out of the forest and walked on the water and talked with us. Even the fish stuck their heads out of the water to speak with us. It seemed like a fairy tale, with no limits on what Jesus was able to do for us. Jesus had much joy performing these things for us, and then, with the countenance of a playful child, said, “Abra Cadabra” and we were all back in the theater.

Jesus read one more: request, “Father, You said that unless you built your church, all of our labor would be in vain. So would you now build your

church like the one described in your word?" Jesus looked up and said, "**Church, Be**". A beautiful spirit filled the room and it began to stretch forth itself as though it were changing itself into some manner of rope. This spiritual yarn began to move in and out of our bodies, actually knitting our hearts together in a love that was more beautiful than the spirit itself. I felt a love for my brethren that was nothing like anything that I had ever experienced before. I felt a feeling of oneness with everyone and a feeling of a unity in liberty. The love freed our minds of all our judgments of others and we had the liberty to be ourselves without having to control our situation or please someone else. There was no selfishness in this love.

The last card read, "Lord, I have one desire—that you might give me a new heart and a new mind so that I might be changed into the image of my Father who is in heaven. I would love to have a mind that did not think it was robbery to think that I could be equal with my God." With tears of joy in his eyes, Jesus said, "**Done!**"

We all witnessed another spirit come forth out of Jesus that was even more awesome than the spirit that had brought brotherly love into our hearts. It was as if the first spirit we saw was as only one color of a rainbow, but this spirit contained all of the colors contained in a rainbow. Now we love our heavenly Father with all of our heart, all of our soul, all of our minds, and all of our being. Then we were filled with a manner of love for our brethren where we would gladly lay down our lives for them. Not only this, but we were filled with a love for those who hated us, had offended us, used us, persecuted us, slandered us, were evil and unthankful. As if that were not enough, we were filled with a love for the unlovable; all who had not met this world's approval, had been outcast, despised, neglected, or rejected.

We knew that there was never an end to the performance that we had just witnessed. It was rather a beginning that would never have an end. As I left the theater, I looked back to see how the marquee described what I had just seen.

On the left side of the theater read, "**Mystery Babylon; the false church**"
Starring all of the foolish who desire to be glorified and exalted as gods."

The marquee on the right read, "**New Jerusalem, the church of Jesus Christ**"; **Starring Jesus Christ, and all those who came out of mystery Babylon.**" Across the bottom of the marquee was written: "**Coming Soon; very soon: The 144,000 who were redeemed with love and have overcome the world.**"
